


WHAT IS INSIDE A VOLCANO?



COMPLETE THE VOLCANO DIAGRAM USING THE WORDS BELOW!

Magma Chamber – Reservoir of magma beneath the volcano.

Conduit Pipe – The channel the magma takes to the surface.

Crater – Depression in the rock caused by volcanic activity.

Lava Flow – A mass of flowing or solidified lava.

Ash Cloud – Volcanic material thrown into the air by an eruption.

Secondary Vent – Where magma escapes the volcano away from the main vent.

Lava & Ash Layers – The body of the volcano formed by multiple past eruptions.

Bedrock – The solid rock through which the magma moves.

Sill – Volcanic intrusion which runs between beds of rock.

Dyke – Volcanic intrusion which cuts through beds of rock.
